

CloseEngine Function

Description

Closes an OpenEngine handle referenced by [CreateEngine\(\)](#)

The connection will close. The behavior of the engine will depend on the flags passed in the call to [CreateEngine\(\)](#).

Syntax

Error = **CloseEngine** (Engine)

Parameters

The CloseEngine function has the following parameter.

| Parameter | Description |
|---------------|--|
| <i>Engine</i> | Handle for the engine created by CreateEngine(). |

Example

```
// Create an engine that will not shut down when the connections end
// Uses the named pipe REVCAP1_TEST
Error = CreateEngine(Engine, "\\.\REVCAP1_TEST", "EXAMPLES",CREATE_ENGINE_OPEN_ALWAYS$, 1)
// keep the engine open as long as necessary...
Error = CloseEngine(Engine)
```
