

FSMSG Subroutine

Description

Displays an error message, typically after an OpenInsight I/O command such as Open, Read, or Write failed. Available in OpenInsight 4.1.2 and later versions.

Syntax

FSMSG (*messageid*)

Parameters

The FSMSG subroutine has the following parameter.

Parameter	Description
<i>messageid</i>	Optional. The text of the system message with the passed @ID. Typically, you do not use this parameter because you want to display the system error message text by calling FSMSG() with no parameter.

Example

```
Open 'DUMMY' to dummyfilevar else
  call fsmsg()
  return 0
end
/* If the table 'DUMMY' is not attached, the following system message displays */
```



From the System Monitor, if you would like to view the text of a system error message (such as 401), enter:

```
RUN FSMSG 401
```
