

FTPRENAMEFILE Function

Description

Renames a file from an FTP server.

Syntax

filecontents = **FTPFILENAME** (*ftpdomain*, *user*, *password*, *path*, *existing_filename*, *new_filename*)

Parameters

The function has the following parameters:

Parameter	Description
<i>ftpdomain</i>	The domain name of the FTP site.
<i>user</i>	A valid user of the FTP site
<i>password</i>	The password of the user
<i>path</i>	The location of the file being renamed.
<i>existing_filename</i>	The current name of the file being renamed
<i>new_filename</i>	The new filename.

Returns

250 if successful, 503 if failure.

Example

```
declare function FTPFILENAME, msg, utility

ftpdomain = 'my.ftp.site.com'
user = 'someone'
password = 'a valid password'
path = 'myFtpFiles'
existing_filename = 'How To FTP'
new_filename = 'How to Rename FTP files'

message = FTPFILENAME(ftpdomain,user,password,path,existing_filename,new_filename)

if message = 250 else
    msg(@window,'Error in renaming file.  Error Code: ';message)
end
```
