

# FTPSEND Function

## Description

Sends a file to an FTP server.

## Syntax

*filecontents* = **FTPSEND** (*ftpdomain*, *user*, *password*, *path*, *filecontents*, *filename*, *error*)

## Parameters

The function has the following parameters:

Parameter	Description
<i>ftpdomain</i>	The domain name of the FTP site.
<i>user</i>	A valid user of the FTP site
<i>password</i>	The password of the user
<i>path</i>	The location of where to send the file
<i>filecontents</i>	The contents of the file being sent
<i>filename</i>	The name of the file to send
<i>error</i>	Error status returned by function

## Example

```
declare function FTPSEND, msg, utility

ftpdomain = 'my.ftp.site.com'
user = 'someone'
password = 'a valid password'
path = 'myFtpFiles'
filename = 'How_To_FTP'
filecontents = "Test FTP text"

ftpReply = FTPSend(ftpdomain,user,password,path,filecontents,filename,error)

if ftpReply then
  swap char(13):char(10) with '|' in ftpReply
  msg(@window,ftpReply)
end else
  if error then
    x = msg(@window, 'Contents of Error: '::error)
  end else
    x = msg(@window, 'No file returned')
  end
end
```
