

# Inet\_Msg Function

## Description

Converts a message from [Msg\(\)](#) to HTML format.

## Syntax

*return* = **Inet\_Msg**(*Request*, *MsgRec*, *MsgId*, *argv*)

## Parameters

The Inet\_Msg function has the following parameters:

Parameters	Description
Request	[in] HTTP-request
MsgRec	[in] Message definition structure (can be null if MsgKey set)
MsgId	[in] Name of the message to execute (can be null if MsgRec is set)
Argv	[in] @fm delimited list of substitutable parameters

## Returns

A message in HTML format.

## Example

In BASIC+, to output the message **No Information to Display** in an **Inet\_** procedure, code the following:

```
VarHtml = Inet_Msg(Request, 'Error <br> No Information to display')
```
