

Inet_Test_Connect Function

Description

Internet procedure, executed from a Web browser, that tests whether **OE CGI/OE CGI2** is running on a Web server.

Syntax

Inet_Test_Connect(*Request*)

Note: Request is any text after the string INET_TEST_CONNECT?

Parameters

The Inet_Test_Connect function has the following parameter:

| Parameters | Description |
|------------|---|
| Request | [in] HTTP-request. |
| return | [out] Incoming request as an HTML script. |

Returns

Incoming request as an HTML script, displayed in the Web browser.

Example

To test whether **OE CGI/OE CGI2** is properly installed, use the IP address **127.0.0.1** (the localhost loopback address), and enter the following URL in the server's Web browser:

```
http://127.0.0.1/cgi-bin/oecgi.exe/Inet_Test_Connect
```

If OE CGI/OE CGI2 is properly installed, the following HTML will be returned:

```
<!DOCTYPE html>
<html>
  <head>
    <title>
      OpenInsight Inet_Test_Connect Response
    </title>
  </head>
  <body >
    <H1>Congratulations!</h1>
    <br>If you can read this, you have successfully connected to OpenInsight
  </body>

```
