

Set_Env Routine

Description

Defines the value of an environment attribute or list of attributes for the current database.

Syntax

Set_Env (*attributelist*, *valuelist*, *transactflag*)

Parameters

The Set_Env routine has the following parameters.

Parameter	Description
<i>attributelist</i>	One or more attribute identifiers from the list of attributes in the table following the description of this command.
<i>valuelist</i>	Specifies a value for each attribute identifier defined in <i>attributelist</i> .
<i>transactflag</i>	If true (1), all values in <i>valuelist</i> must be valid or no attributes are set. If <i>transactflag</i> is false (0) or null, valid attributes are set and invalid attributes are ignored. A column is returned for each attribute in <i>attributelist</i> . If a valid value is provided, the column is true (1). If an invalid value is provided, the column is false (0).

Example (disabling the debugger)

```
/* in this example, the debug statement does not go to the debugger
   because the debugger is disabled */
$insert environ_constants
declare subroutine set_env
on_off = 0
t_flag = 1
set_env(ENV_DEBUGGER_ENABLED$, on_off, t_flag)
debug
```
