

# Transact Subroutine

## Description

Controls transaction processing.

**Note:** *The TRANSACT volume (in the RevSoft\OI32bit folder) must be attached for transaction control to be enabled.*

## Syntax

**Transact** (*Action*, *SQLstate*)

## Parameters

The Transact subroutine has the following parameters.

Parameter	Description								
<i>Action</i>	Action requested for transaction processing: <table><tr><th>Action</th><th>Meaning</th></tr><tr><td>0</td><td>Rollback transaction</td></tr><tr><td>1</td><td>Commit transaction</td></tr><tr><td>2</td><td>Initialize transaction processing</td></tr></table>	Action	Meaning	0	Rollback transaction	1	Commit transaction	2	Initialize transaction processing
Action	Meaning								
0	Rollback transaction								
1	Commit transaction								
2	Initialize transaction processing								
<i>SQLstate</i>	A variable which, after the call to Transact, will hold the return code. If SQLstate = 0, the call was successful. Otherwise, the call was unsuccessful. Pass a variable initialized to null.
