

3.x - HTTP_Aborted_Service

If an unexpected error occurred with a request, the [3.x - HTTP_MCP controller](#) will be called again with the ProcErr argument populated. The nature of the error (usually a runtime error) will be contained in the ProcErr argument. This routine is a template for generating a response so the caller will receive a well formatted reply.

Syntax

```
Response = HTTP_Aborted_Service(ProcErr)
```

Parameters

Parameter	Description
ProcErr	The procedural error data being passed in from the OEngineServer. Unless otherwise changed, the only reason this should be called is if there was a runtime error in one of the stored procedures that was called by the initial request.

Remarks

[HTTP_Aborted_Service](#) handles aborted HTTP Requests either due to Runtime Errors or Status Errors. If the Debugger Intercept has been enabled, this handler will only receive Status Error aborts.
