

## 3.x - SetOECGIProcErr

Sets the HTTP ProcErr that the OECGI creates to memory so it can be retrieved by later routines. This avoids the need to pass this around into various routines.

### Syntax

```
Response = HTTP_Services('SetOECGIProcErr', ProcErr)
```
