

## 3.x - SetQueryField

Sets the indicated Query field with the indicated value.

### Syntax

```
Response = HTTP_Services('SetQueryField', Field, Value)
```

### Returns

N/A

### Parameters

Parameter	Description
Field	Query field to set. <b>Required.</b>
Value	Value for the Query field. This will be Trimmed to enforce proper formatting. <b>Required.</b>

### Remarks

Query Fields are what appears at the end of a URL which are in this format:

`?<field1>=<value1>[&<field2>=<value2>]`

Hence, an example of a full URL with a Query Field would look like this:

<https://www.mysite.com/api/contacts?name=smith>

Query Fields are often used by an API to filter content. The *SetQueryField* service provides a similar functionality as the [Inet\\_QueryParam](#) function, although the latter is only useful with the [RUN\\_OECGI\\_REQUEST](#) dispatch routine.
