

OConv

Description

Use the keyword OConv to specify a new or alternate output conversion (output format) for a column. The override specification can be any valid output conversion or formatting specification. Output conversions are most typically used to format columns containing data for money, date, time, or logical (Boolean) values (example: **Y** and **N**).

Syntax

COLUMN **Oconv** "output_format"

Parameter

OConv has the following parameter.

Parameter	Description
output_format	Specify a valid output format for output_format.

Examples

```
* In this example, the column Order_Date will be displayed with * a date conversion that prints 2 digits for
the year,
* and delimits month, day, and year with "-".
stmt = 'LIST INVOICES ID ORDER_NUMBER ORDER_DATE OCONV "D2-" '
