ACTIVATED

Description

Occurs when a window or control on a window gets focus. Activating an MDI child also activates the frame

Syntax

bforward = ACTIVATED (ctrlentID, ctrlclassID)

Parameters

ACTIVATED accepts arguments for the following parameters.

Parameter	Description
ctrlentID	Has the format <i>WindowName</i> . <i>ControlName</i> , where <i>WindowName</i> is the identifier of the window that contains the affected control, and <i>ControlName</i> is the identifier of the control. Notice that a period separates the two values.
ctrlclassID	The type of control that recognizes the event. The window control type is the only valid entry.

Returns

True or false. If false, the program execution returns to the calling procedure. If true, the event processing goes to the next level.

Remarks

Instead of using the GOTFOCUS and LOSTFOCUS for a window, use ACTIVATED and INACTIVATED. GOTFOCUS and LOSTFOCUS usually only happen once for a window, immediately after creation.
