CLICK

Description

Occurs when a user presses, then releases, the mouse button over a control.

Syntax

bforward = CLICK (ctrlentID, ctrlclassID)

Parameters

CLICK accepts arguments for the following parameters.

Parameter	Description		
ctrlentID	Has the format WindowName.ControlName, where WindowName is the identifier of the window that contains the affected control, and ntrolName is the identifier of the control. Notice that a period separates the two values.		
ctrlclassID	The type of control	that recognizes the event. Valid entries are:

	CHECKBMP	Check box with a bitmap on it.	
	CHECKBOX	Check box.	
	EDITTABLE	Edit table.	
	ICON	Icon.	
	PUSHBMP	Push-button with a bitmap on it.

	TABCONTROL	Sets and navigates to the tab which was selected.	

Returns

True or false. If false, the program execution returns to the calling procedure. If true, then event processing goes to the next level.

Remarks

To determine the clicked row in an edit table, use the NOTIFYPOS property. For the CHECKBMP and CHECKBOX types, use the CHECK property to get the current state; for the RADIOBUTTON types, use the VALUE property.
