

CLOSE

Description

Occurs when a window closes.

Syntax

`bforward = CLOSE (ctrlentID, ctrlclassID, cancelflag)`

Parameters

CLOSE accepts arguments for the following parameters.

Parameter	Description
<code>ctrlentID</code>	Has the format <code>WindowName.ControlName</code> , where <code>WindowName</code> is the identifier of the window that contains the affected control, and <code>ControlName</code> is the identifier of the control. Notice that a period separates the two values.
<code>ctrlclassID</code>	The type of control that recognizes the event. The window control type is the only valid entry.
<code>cancelflag</code>	If, false (0) then cancel the close process. If true (1), then continue with close.

Returns

True or false. If false, the program execution returns to the calling procedure. If true, the event processing goes to the next level.

Remarks

The most common reason that a form will not close is the use of **Return 0** instead of **Return 1** in the close event.
