DSOCOMMIT

Description

Event that triggers writing of DataSet updates to the data source.

Syntax

bforward = DSOCOMMIT (ctrlentID, ctrlclassID, DSOID, ExecuteAfterCommit, CommitTransaction)

Parameters

DSOCOMMIT accepts arguments for the following parameters.

Parameter	Description
CtrlentID	Has the format WindowName.ControlName, where WindowName is the identifier of the window that contains the affected control, and ControlName is the identifier of the control. Notice that a period separates the two values.
CtrlclassID	The type of control that recognizes the event.
DSOID	The name of the DataSet, or the ordinal number of the DataSet (its position in the list of DataSets that appears in the Form Designer's Ed it Selection Criteria dialog box).
ExecuteAfter Commit	Code that is to be executed after the commitment.
CommitTran saction	Indicates that a commit transaction should occur at the data source - supported only by databases that support transaction control.

Returns

True or false. If false, then program execution returns to the calling procedure. If true, then event processing goes to the next level.
