

# DSOEXECUTE

## Description

Executes a DataSet definition script to establish a DataSet object.

## Syntax

*bforward* = **DSOEXECUTE** (*ctrlentID*, *ctrlclassID*, *DSOID*)

## Parameters

DSOEXECUTE accepts arguments for the following parameters.

Parameter	Description
<i>CtrlentID</i>	Has the format <i>WindowName.ControlName</i> , where <i>WindowName</i> is the identifier of the window that contains the affected control, and <i>ControlName</i> is the identifier of the control. Notice that a period separates the two values.
<i>ctrlclassID</i>	The type of control that recognizes the event. The window control type is the only valid entry.
<i>DSOID</i>	The name of the DataSet, or the ordinal number of the DataSet (its position in the list of DataSets that appears in the Form Designer's <i>Edit Selection Criteria</i> dialog box).

## Returns

True or false. If false, then program execution returns to the calling procedure. If true, then event processing goes to the next level.

## Remarks

The READ event sends DSOEXECUTE events to all DataSets that the form is bound to.
