

DSOLAST

Description

Go to the last record in the DataSet.

Syntax

`bforward = DSOLAST (ctrlentID, ctrlclassID, DSOID)`

Parameters

DSOLAST accepts arguments for the following parameters.

| Parameter | Description |
|--------------------------|--|
| <code>ctrlentID</code> | Has the format <code>WindowName.ControlName</code> , where <code>WindowName</code> is the identifier of the window that contains the affected control, and <code>ControlName</code> is the identifier of the control. Notice that a period separates the two values. |
| <code>ctrlclassID</code> | The type of control that recognizes the event. The window control type is the only valid entry. |
| <code>DSOID</code> | The name of the DataSet, or the ordinal number of the DataSet (its position in the list of DataSets that appears in the Form Designer's <i>Edit Selection Criteria</i> dialog box). |

Returns

True or false. If false, then program execution returns to the calling procedure. If true, then event processing goes to the next level.
