

INSERTROW

Description

Occurs when a row gets inserted into an edit table.

Syntax

bforward = **INSERTROW** (*ctrlentID*, *ctrlclassID*, *rownum*)

Parameters

INSERTROW accepts arguments for the following parameters.

Parameter	Description
<i>ctrlentID</i>	Has the format <i>WindowName.ControlName</i> , where <i>WindowName</i> is the identifier of the window that contains the affected control, and <i>ControlName</i> is the identifier of the control. Notice that a period separates the two values.
<i>ctrlclassID</i>	The type of control that recognizes the event. The edit table control type is the only valid entry.
<i>rownum</i>	Inserted row number.

Returns

True or false. If false, the program execution returns to the calling procedure. If true, the event processing goes to the next level.
