Description

Executes a specified page action.

Syntax

bforward = **PAGE** (*ctrlentID*, *ctrlclassID*, *pageaction*)

Parameters

PAGE accepts arguments for the following parameters.

Parameter	Description	
<i>ctrlentID</i>	Has the format <i>WindowName.ControlName</i> , where <i>WindowName</i> is the identifier of the window that contains the affected control, and <i>ControlName</i> is the identifier of the control. Notice that a period separates the two values.	
<i>ctrlclassID</i>	The type of control that recognizes the event. The window control type is the only valid entry.	
<i>pageaction</i>	pageaction may be one of the following:	
Value	Description	
<number>	Go to the specified page. If <0, then 1. If > max page, then maximum (last) page.	
'+'	Go to the next page, no wraparound.	
'++'	Go to the next page, wraparound.	
'-'	Go to the previous page, no wrap.	
'--'	Go to the previous page, wraparound.	
'L'	Go to the last page. Passing a large number will do the same.	

Returns

True or false. If false, the program execution returns to the calling procedure. If true, the event processing goes to the next level.

The PAGE event is used to change the page. To trap a page change event, use the VSCROLL event for the window.
