JustLen

Description

Use the keyword JustLen to override the justification or display length of a column as stored in the dictionary. You can override the justification or display length separately, or can combine the override specification in one command.

Syntax

COLUMN JUSTLEN "just" | length | "justlen"

Remarks

The override specification for JustLen can be an integer value, alpha characters, or a combination of these.

Examples

* This displays the COMPANY column with a length of 40

* characters.

stmt = "LIST CUSTOMER COMPANY JUSTLEN 40"
Run_Report("",stmt)

* Displays the COMPANY column right-justified.

stmt = "LIST CUSTOMER COMPANY JustLen "R"
Run_Report("",stmt)

* In this example, the COMPANY column is displayed

* left-justified, 40 characters wide.

stmt = "LIST CUSTOMER COMPANY JUSTLEN "L40"'
