

Alpha Function

Description

The Alpha function returns true (1) if the expression contains non-numeric characters (including punctuation). If the expression contains a numeric value, false (0) is returned.

Syntax

value = **Alpha**(*expression*)

Example

```
* B is set to true.  
A = "BASIC+"  
B = Alpha(A)  
  
* B is set to false.  
A = "1992"  
B = Alpha(A)
```
