

Quote Function

Description

Places double quotation marks around a given expression.

Syntax

quoted = **Quote** (*expression*)

Parameters

The Quote function has the following parameters.

Parameter	Description
<i>Expression</i>	Any legal BASIC+ expression.

The expression can also be enclosed in double quote marks (") by using other BASIC+ methods, but the resulting code is more confusing. For example, the following two lines of code are equivalent:

```
Sel = 'Select CM With Date "' :DT: '''  
Sel = "Select CM With Date " :Quote(DT)
```

Quote is an internal function and does not have to be declared.

Example

```
Return = "THE VALUE " : Quote(var) : " IS OUT OF RANGE"  
/* The values contained in VAR are bounded by double quotation marks. */
```
