

CTRLMAP

Applies to

Description

Returns an @FM-delimited list of control identifiers, as they apply to the specified window, including the menu.

Note: *The list that is returned orders its contents by the tab order, allowing the user another way to manipulate controls in conjunction with using the tab order.*

Usage

Return the identifiers for all controls on the specified window:

`controlIds = Get_Property (windowname, "CTRLMAP")`

Returns

Value returned by Get_Property:

Value	Description
ControlIds	Identifiers for all controls belonging to the specified window.

Example

```
* (in some stored procedure, like a button click)

Declare Function Get_Property, Set_Property
Map = Get_Property(@WINDOW, "CTRLMAP")

* assuming the first control in the tab order has a TEXT property
rslt = Set_Property(Map<1>, "TEXT", "Change Me")
return 0
```
