

MAXIMIZE SIZE

Applies to

Window

Description

The MAXIMIZE SIZE sets and retrieves the maximum size coordinates for a window. This property is useful when a window requires a maximum size less than the size of the display screen.

Usage

MaximizeSize = **Get_Property** (*objectname*, "MAXIMIZE SIZE")

ExistingMaximizeSize = **Set_Property** (*objectname*, "MAXIMIZE SIZE", *array*)

Remarks

Values passed in Set_Property():

Value	Description	
array	An @fm delimited array of minimum and maximum heights and widths.	
	Position	Description
	<1>	The offset from the left side of the window. The window's X coordinate.
	<2>	The offset from the top side of the window. The window's Y coordinate.
	<3>	The width of the window.
	<4>	The height of the window.

Returns

Values returned by Get_Property and Set_Property

Value	Description
<i>MaximizeSize</i>	An @fm delimited array of the maximum size of a window.
<i>ExistingMaximizeSize</i>	An @fm delimited array of the maximum size of a window, when Set_Property was run.

Example

```
* This snippet of code will retrieve the current size of the window and set the MAXIMIZE size to the retrieved value.

CurSize = Get_Property(@Window, "SIZE")
maxSize = Set_Property(@Window, "MAXIMIZE SIZE", CurSize)
```
