

MAXIMIZESIZE

Applies to

Window

Description

The MAXIMIZESIZE sets and retrieves the maximum size coordinates for a window. This property is useful when a window requires a maximum size less than the size of the display screen.

Usage

`MaximizeSize = Get_Property (objectname, "MAXIMIZESIZE")`

`ExistingMaximizeSize = Set_Property (objectname, "MAXIMIZESIZE", array)`

Remarks

Values passed in Set_Property():

Value	Description	
array	An @fm delimited array of minimum and maximum heights and widths.	
Position	Description	
<1>	The offset from the left side of the window. The window's X coordinate.	
<2>	The offset from the top side of the window. The window's Y coordinate.	
<3>	The width of the window.	
<4>	The height of the window.	

Returns

Values returned by Get_Property and Set_Property

Value	Description
MaximizeSize	An @fm delimited array of the maximum size of a window.
ExistingMaximizeSize	An @fm delimited array of the maximum size of a window, when Set_Property was run.

* This snippet of code will retrieve the current size of the window and set the MAXIMIZE size to the retrieved value.  
  
CurSize = Get_Property(@Window, "SIZE")  
maxSize = Set_Property(@Window, "MAXIMIZESIZE", CurSize)
```
