

Set Printer LINE

Description

The LINE message is used to print a line at a specific location on the page using the current line style. The line style is set with the [LINESTYLE](#) message. The Repeat message is used to print the line on every page.

Parameters

Parameter	Description of Fields	Comments	Default
Parm1 - Location	<1> X1	Starting X position	0
	<2> Y1	Starting Y position	0
	<3> X2	Ending X position	0
	<4> Y2	Ending Y position	0
Parm2 - Repeat	<1> Repeat on all pages	0=Current page only 1=Print on all pages

/* The following example uses the LINE message to print a bold line across the top of every page. */
declare function Set_Printer
$insert OIPRINT_EQUATES
stat = Set_Printer("INIT") ; Start printing
stat = Set_Printer("HEADER", "Test Header")
stat = Set_Printer("LINESTYLE", PS_SOLID:@fm:5) ;* 5 point line
Print a line at the top of the page
stat = Set_Printer("LINE", 0:@fm:1:@fm:7.5:@fm:1, 1)
stat = Set_Printer("TERM") ;* End printing
```
