

Set Printer POLYGON

Description

The POLYGON message is used to print closed polygons with the current line style and fill style. The line and fill styles are set with the [LINESTYLE](#) and [FILLSTYLE](#) messages. The Points parameter sets the points in the polygon. The format of the points is X:@VM:Y with @FM between points. The polygon will be printed on every page if the Repeat parameter is set.

Parameters

Parameter	Description of Fields	Comments	Default
Parm1 - Points	X1:@VM:Y1:@FM:X2:@VM:Y2	@FM between points, and @VM between X and Y	""
Parm2 - Repeat	<1> Repeat on all pages	0=Current page only 1=Print on all pages

declare function Set_Printer
stat = Set_Printer("INIT") ;* Start printing
points = ""
points<1> = 1:@VM:1
points<2> = 2:@VM:2
points<3> = 0:@VM:2
stat = Set_Printer("POLYGON", points, 1)
stat = Set_Printer("TERM") ;* End printing
```
