The format used to render dates in the time bar.

Remarks

The DateHeaderFormat property allows you to customize how dates are drawn in the timer bar header.

This only works for multi-date [views](#).

Here are the date formatting options:

Character(s)	Displays
YY	Years 00-99
YYYY	Years 0001-2999
M	Months 1-12
MM	Months 01-12
MMM	Months Jan-Dec
MMMM	Months January-December
MMMMM	Months J-D
D	Days 1-31
DD	Days 01-31
DDD	Days Sun-Sat
DDDD	Days Sunday-Saturday

Here are some example date formats, all them for January 1, 2006:

To Display As	Use
January 1, 2006	MMMM D, YYYY
Sunday, Jan 01, 2006	DDDD, MMM DD, YYYY
2006-01-01	YYYY-MM-DD

// Change the format of dates in the time bar
Set_Property(@Window:".OLE_SCHEDULE", "OLE.DateHeaderFormat", "DD-MM-YYYY")
```
