

GetQueryField

Returns the value previously set for the indicated Query Field. If then indicated Query Field has not been set then then an error condition will be set.

Syntax

```
Response = HTTP_Services('GetQueryField', Field)
```

Returns

The value for the specified Query Field.

Parameters

| Parameter | Description |
|-----------|--------------------------------------|
| Field | Query Field to get. Required. |

Remarks

Query Fields are what appears at the end of a URL which are in this format:

```
?<field1>=<value1>[&<field2>=<value2>]
```

Hence, an example of a full URL with a Query Field would look like this:

```
https://www.mysite.com/api/contacts?name=smith
```

Query Fields are often used by an API to filter content. The *GetQueryField* service provides a similar functionality as the [Inet_QueryParam](#) function, although the latter is only useful with the [RUN_OECGI_REQUEST](#) dispatch routine.
