

# SetQueryFields

Sets all of the Query Fields based on the content of the HTTP request that the OECGI creates.

## Syntax

```
Response = HTTP_Services('SetQueryFields')
```

## Returns

N/A

## Parameters

## Remarks

This assumes the [SetOECGIRequest](#) service has already been called so that the Request array is in memory. The [SetQueryField](#) service is used to perform the actual setting of the values. Query Fields are what appears at the end of a URL which are in this format:

```
?<field1>=<value1>[&<field2>=<value2>]
```

Hence, an example of a full URL with a Query Field would look like this:

```
https://www.mysite.com/api/contacts?name=smith
```

Query Fields are often used by an API to filter content. The *SetQueryFields* service provides a similar functionality as the [Inet\\_QueryParam](#) function, although the latter is only useful with the [RUN\\_OECGI\\_REQUEST](#) dispatch routine.
