

The ZOOM Menu Item Settings

Assign **F3** as an accelerator key for a menu item called **EDIT.ZOOM**. This menu option can be visible or hidden. In an MDI frame, the Zoom functionality will operate on the control that has focus in the active window. In a window without an MDI frame, the Zoom functionality will operate on the control that has focus -- the active window is the window containing the menu. The settings, with the menu item visible, are illustrated below:
